

ALERT Spokane Opt Out Request Form

Background: Spokane County has an Emergency Notification System (“ENS”) called ALERT Spokane, which can send emergency messages via telephone. The ENS is for the benefit of the general public. If you have local phone services provided by CenturyLink or Frontier, your landline is automatically included in the ENS database. As such, if ALERT Spokane is used by emergency response personnel, you may receive information about an emergency event.

Details: The undersigned hereby requests that the identified landline telephone number be removed from the ENS database and be placed on the DO NOT CALL list.

The undersigned recognizes that removal of the identified landline telephone number from the ENS database will eliminate the possibility of that landline telephone number receiving any information about emergency events at any time that may arise in or near where the landline is located.

The undersigned waives any claims against Spokane County and its response partner agencies due to the removal of the identified landline telephone number from the ENS database and therefore not receiving any information about emergency events at any time that may arise in or near where the landline is located.

The undersigned also acknowledges that if they would like to opt back in, it is their responsibility to do so by registering online through www.alertspokane.org
