

IDENTIFICATION

You must provide one of the following type of identification.

- Government Issued picture identification; card or driver's license. (*Photocopies are not acceptable*)
- Identification that has expired will not be accepted. **An exception will be made for Active Duty military ID or for states that do not issue identification with an expiration date.*
- Temporary paper identification with the temporary expiration date.

Juveniles:

- All juveniles must have a Government issued birth certificate. Hospital copy will be accepted if child is born within the past 30 days.
- Court Order signed by judge/commissioner designating legal guardianship.

You may not be allowed to visit if:

- There is an emergency within the facility / change of inmate housing location, or an inmate is unavailable due to court appearance.
- You have been released from custody in the last 30 days.
- You refuse to submit to being searched.
- If you are on supervised probation or other forms of court monitored supervision or community custody; a letter authorizing you to visit must be sent by your supervising agency.
- You are currently serving a sentence on Home Confinement, EHM, Pre-Release, Furlough, etc.
- You attempt to enter the facility with contraband.

If you have been released from custody in the last 90 days you will not be allowed contact visiting; however you will be allowed non-contact visitation after 30 days release from custody.

CODE OF CONDUCT

To ensure a safe and pleasant visit, we ask that inmates and visitors abide by the code of conduct.

- Weapons of any kind are not permitted in the facilities.
- Visitors may need to reschedule if they have been drinking, or have the appearance or smell of intoxicants prior to entry into the facilities.
- Visiting may need to be rescheduled if a visitor needs to leave during the visit for any reason. Restroom breaks are not permitted during visits.
- Children must be under direct supervision and within sight of the visiting parent/guardian at all times. Roughhousing and horseplay is not allowed. Physical discipline of children is not allowed.
- Use of profanity will not be tolerated and can terminate an/or suspend future visits.
- No yelling outside the facility to inmates.
- During contact visits with Work Crew inmates, one hug is allowed at the beginning and end of visit (no kissing), sit across from each other and hands on top of the table.
- **Smoking, food or beverages are not permitted in the public lobbies or in the visiting areas.**
Exception: baby bottle for infants.

DRESS CODE

Individuals determined to be inappropriately dressed may need to reschedule their visit. It is recommended that the visitor dress conservatively. Determination of appropriateness is at the Receptionist/Visiting Officer's discretion.

Any alteration to clothing once in the visiting area may cause the visit to be rescheduled. Clothing must fit appropriately.

- Shoes are required. (No steel toed boots or shoes).
- No belts.
- Dresses, skirts, and shorts must be mid-thigh or longer.
- No tube tops, halter tops, or transparent clothing.
- Proper undergarments are required to be worn
- No sexually explicit, obscene/offensive language or gang referencing material.

VISITING YOUR INMATE

- You must be on the offender's approved visiting list before you will be allowed to visit. The offender must know your full name and date of birth and put in a request for you to be added to his/her visiting list.
- All visitors in your party need to check in with the Visiting Officer or Receptionist at the same time.
- You will receive a token for the parcel lockers located to the east of the counter. You will need to lock up all your personal belongings.
- Juveniles being accompanied by a parent or legal guardian may be permitted to visit; proof of guardianship is required. See "Identification".
- During a fire alarm or other emergency, you may be told to leave the area. Leave only if told to do so. You will be directed to the stairs by an employee.
