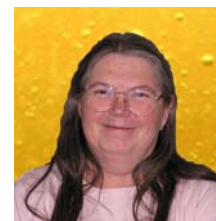

## BEES AND HONEY DEPARTMENT RULES

1. The Inland Empire Beekeepers Association invites everyone interested in bees and beekeeping to submit entries.
2. Exhibitor is responsible to read “General Rules” as well as the Department Rules.
3. All exhibitors must use official entry forms and they must be postmarked on or before August 11, to Fair Entries, 404 N Havana Street Ste 1, Spokane Valley WA 99202-4663.
4. Each item entered may compete for only one premium and therefore may only be entered in one class and one lot associated with that class.
5. The Fair is not responsible for loss or damage.
6. Superintendents shall be in full charge of the department to which they are assigned.
7. Judges have the right to open any container.
8. Exhibitors must present claim ticket when picking up their exhibit and must not remove exhibit unless superintendent or assistant is present to check out the exhibit. No exhibit shall be withdrawn before Monday, September 21.
