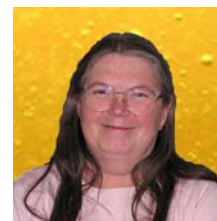

CREATURE FEATURE DEPARTMENT RULES

1. Exhibitor is responsible to read “General Rules” as well as Department Rules.
2. All exhibitors must use official entry forms and they must be postmarked on or before August 11, to Fair Entries, 404 N Havana Street Ste 1, Spokane Valley WA 99202-4663.
3. Kids 11 and Over - Exhibitor, and one adult chaperon, will be given free access to the Fair to submit entry only between the times listed above. Adult Exhibitors - Exhibitor will be given free access to the Fair to submit entry only between the times listed above.
4. Each item may compete for one premium and may be entered in one class or lot. The exhibitor may enter each class, but only one entry to a class.
5. Items used in the exhibit need not be grown by the exhibitor. Use your imagination and have fun.
6. Do not use any man-made material for special effects, e.g. aluminum, cloth, or glass. **KEEP IT NATURAL.**
7. After Monday, September 15, any exhibitors who have not come for their entries shall forfeit ribbons and exhibits that shall be disposed of at the discretion of the management.
8. Exhibit must fit on a 12" shelf.
9. The Fair is not responsible for loss or damage.
10. Superintendents shall be in full charge of the department to which they are assigned.
11. Exhibitors must present claim ticket when picking up their exhibit and must not remove exhibit unless superintendent or assistant is present to check out the exhibit. No exhibit shall be withdrawn before Monday, September 21.
