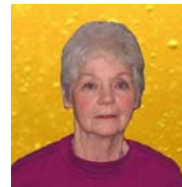

GRANGE BOOTH DEPARTMENT RULES

1. All exhibitors must contact Superintendent Bonnie Reed at 328-2681 to reserve a space PRIOR to submitting an entry.
2. Exhibitor is responsible to read "General Rules" at beginning of Exhibitor's Guide.
3. All exhibitors must use official entry forms and they must be postmarked on or before August 11, to Fair Entries, 404 N Havana Street Ste 1, Spokane Valley WA 99202-4663.
4. All flammable material must be fire proofed.
5. Colored / natural colored grains and seed may be used in decorating the booth. Produce, if used, shall be kept fresh by replacing same when necessary. All jars must be sealed.
6. No company or brand name advertising allowed in booth.
7. Name plates shall be of uniform size (4" x 24") and placed on the center front face of each booth. Grange booths will be judged by number and name plates will be covered during judging.
8. A booth with moving parts should be manned during judging.
9. Each grange entry may purchase two (2) attendant passes good for all ten days of the Fair to maintain the display for \$20.00 each.
10. Scoring will be based upon depiction of theme (150 points), originality and development of theme (200 points), quality of materials used (175 points), quality of workmanship (100 points), color and design (100 points), simplicity (100 points), balance (100 points), and unity (75 points). Total possible is 1,000 points through each of the three judging teams.

SPECIAL AWARDS

Subordinate Granges with the highest total score in "General Attractiveness" will receive the ELLSWORTH C. FRENCH MEMORIAL TROPHY for one year.

People's Choice Award will receive a trophy.

Ribbons will be placed Friday, September 11.

DEPARTMENT O CLASS 1 (DISPLAYS)

Granges not placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd will receive a participation rosette. All booths scoring 75% of total points possible (or more) will receive \$150.00. Judging competition is open to all granges. This year's Fair theme is "We've Got Something to Crow About" and each booth shall represent a phase of Grange activity. All booths will be 30" high at the front with the floor sloping to 4.5' height at the back, with 2' high sides and a 3' back. Booths are 10' wide by 6' deep and include electrical outlets.

Lot 1 (Subordinate Granges):	1 st - \$150.00, trophy, rosette	2 nd - \$90.00 and rosette	3 rd - \$75.00 and rosette
Lot 2 (Junior Granges):	1 st - Trophy and rosette	2 nd - Rosette	3 rd - Rosette
Lot 3 (Pomona Granges / Special Interest Departments):	1 st - Trophy and rosette	2 nd - Rosette	3 rd - Rosette
