SEWING DEPARTMENT RULES

1. Exhibitor may enter only one entry per lot.
2. Exhibitor is responsible to read "General Rules" at beginning of Exhibitor's Guide.
3. All exhibitors must use official entry forms and they must be postmarked on or before August 11, to Fair Entries, 404 N Havana Street Ste 1, Spokane Valley WA 99202-4663.
4. Superintendent shall be in full charge of the department.
5. Articles showing wear or soiled articles will be disqualified.
6. Exhibitors must present claim ticket when picking up their exhibit and must not remove exhibit unless superintendent or assistant is present to check out the exhibit. No exhibit shall be withdrawn before Monday, September 21.
7. The Fair is not responsible for hangers or bags left with articles.
8. The following will be considered in judging sewing: Value of article in relation to work done and material used, suitability of material to purpose, workmanship including appearance on right and wrong sides, design adapted to area / keeps with function, color suitability and coordination, as well as general appearance including clean and pressed.
9. All items entered in Department J should be sewing or needlework using fabric, yarn or thread.
10. A dress, suit, or pajamas is considered one garment, whether 1 or 2 pieces. Indicate number of pieces on entry tag.
11. An incomplete entry will be disqualified.

Special Awards

(Open) The Washington State Quilters Guild of Spokane, Washington will be awarding a WSQ ribbon and \$50.00 cash prize to the in the Adult Open Division that shows best work in construction, use of color and design and application of hand quilting and machine quilting design. The quilt (or wall hanging) must be entirely pieced and quilted by the exhibitor.

(Open) Machine Embroiderers of Oregon and Washington (MEO) is pleased to offer a certificate and special ribbon to the exhibitor whose entry is chosen by the Department Judge as the Best Overall Entry in the sewing machine arts category of a machine embroidered item / free-motion embroidery and another certificate and special ribbon in computerized embroidery.

(Open) Boyd Walker Sewing Machine Company will award a service certificate worth \$70.00 to an outstanding exhibit in the Sewing Department.

(Youth) Boyd Walker Sewing Machine Company will award a basket of sewing notions to an outstanding exhibit in the Sewing Department.

(Open) The Shuttlebird Tattling Guild will award a \$25 Gift Certificate to Sew E-Z Too for the Best Tatted Article in Class 8, Lots 21-25.
