South Hill Resident Locates Stolen Items

On January 30th, while on a walk in a wooded area near the 4800 block of East Stoughton Rd., a South Hill resident located several items conspicuously placed underneath a tarp under a large tree. When the resident looked underneath the tarp he saw a variety of different power tools, electronic devices and other items he did not want to disturb.

Deputy Brandon Armstrong responded to the area where he located the following items hidden under the tarp:

- Flat screen television
- I-pad
- Kindle
- A variety of Dewalt and Makita power tools
- Crystal figurines
- Wooden Katana swords with "SKR" inscriptions
- Variety of beauty products

Investigators believe these were items taken in a string of occupied, residential burglaries that occurred between November and December of 2011 in the South Hill area. The investigation continues.
