**RESOLUTION**  
 SPOKANE COUNTY TRAFFIC CODE  
 46.44.041

WHEREAS, an engineering investigation has been made of the Spokane County Bridges; and

WHEREAS, such investigation has revealed that certain bridges, designated herein, have members which are stressed above what is normally considered safe by certain heavy loads or combinations of loads which might be expected to use the bridges left open to unrestricted use of the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, an engineering study has been made.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, Washington, that use of the following Spokane County Bridges is restricted as hereinafter stated:

**Section No. 46.44.041 – add weight restrictions to the following bridge:**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, Washington, that the load restrictions on the herein designated Spokane County Bridges shall remain in force and effect until the County Engineer certifies that the designated bridge has been reconstructed or is capable of sustaining legal loads, whichever shall first occur.

The County Engineer is hereby directed and authorized to cause to be posted and maintained signs in accordance with this Resolution and the Washington State Department of Transportation's "Manual for Signing".

The restrictions authorized by this resolution shall take effect upon the placement of signs.
