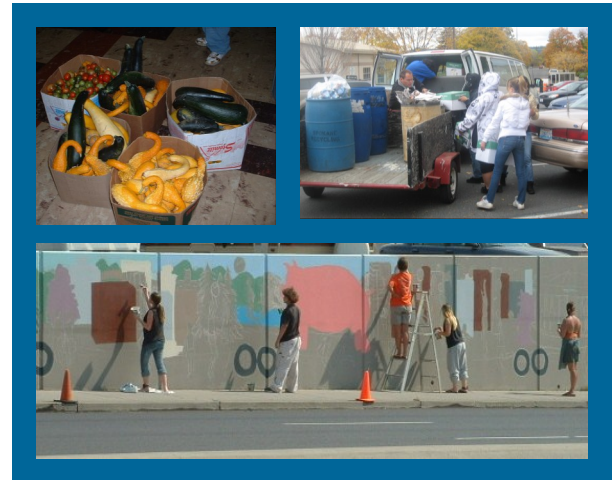

Special Projects:

Recycling Project: youth gather, disassemble, and sort recyclable materials for delivery to local recycling centers.
