

State v Anthony Pritchett/Shomari Jackson:

Charge: Second Degree Felony Murder, based on underlying felony of second degree assault with alternative charge: First Degree Manslaughter.

Facts: Anthony Pritchett punched Richard Morgan in the face, breaking facial bones around the eye. Jackson was "egging Pritchett on" through his words. Morgan fell backward and down on the sidewalk; suffered basal skull fracture. He died approximately one week later in the hospital when family removed life support.

Jackson agreed to cooperate with the State. He pleaded guilty to second degree assault and received the high end of the sentencing range of 14 months. Pritchett pled guilty to First Degree Manslaughter and received high end of 280 months.
