

State v. John Lipinski:

In March 2006, John Lipinski was tried for the double homicide of his girlfriend, Melissa Saldivar and her unborn child, Mataya Saldivar. The trial took two weeks and involved approximately 30 witnesses, many of whom were experts. The evidence established that the defendant arrived at the hospital with the victim. The victim had suffered catastrophic injuries which resulted in her subsequent death. The baby victim was delivered by emergency c-section. The baby died a couple of months later of injuries sustained during the incident that evening. The defendant forcibly ejected the victim out a moving vehicle. It is most likely the victim was dragged for a distance before becoming dislodged from the vehicle. The defendant was convicted of two counts of 2nd Murder and sentenced to 30 years in state prison.
