

State v. Theodore Stewart:

Charge: First degree premeditated murder..

Defendant broke into the victim's apartment with codefendant Raymond Nelson in 2001. The victim was mentally disabled. Both defendant's sexually assaulted the victim, ransacked her residence, and took personal property from the apartment after viciously killing the victim. Defendant Stewart later returned to the apartment, concealed the victim's body by placing clothing and other items over her. The crime was solved years later through DNA testing. Defendant Stewart was convicted by a jury and sentenced to the high end of the standard sentence range of 360 months of incarceration.
