**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** by the Spokane County Steering Committee of Elected Officials, pursuant to Chapter 36.70A RCW, that a public workshop will be held on February 20, 2019 in the Spokane Regional Health District Building, Conference Room M140, 1101 W College Ave, Spokane, WA. The workshop will begin at 9:00 a.m. or as soon as possible thereafter and concluding with the last speaker. If necessary, the meeting may be continued.

The purpose of the workshop is to two-fold. First is to consider growth impacts on the West Plains including potential modifications to Urban Growth Areas adjacent to the City of Cheney and the City of Airway Heights. The second purpose of the workshop is to discuss a shared financing agreement for a proposed study on market factors related to land quantity analysis and urban growth area updates.
