- Commissioner French, Committee Chair, opened the meeting. Welcome/Introductions.
- Motion to approve the minutes from June 12, 2019 made by City Council Member Breean Beggs. Motion carried unanimously.
- Item #3: Committee updates.
  - Strategic planning Committee Cary Driskell gave an update on the newly opened Community Representative position and asked for feedback.
  - Racial Equity Committee Update on the Committee's involvement with the HB 1517 workgroup and the work being done to create a domestic violence risk assessment tool.
  - Motion to support the Racial Equity Committee's participation in a statewide domestic violence working group by City Council Member Breean Beggs. Motion carried unanimously.
- Item #4: Director Mike Sparber gave an update on booking.
  - Body/contraband scanners.
  - Increasing physical space and improving workflows.
- Item #5: Justin Bingham provided an overview of HB 1517.
  - Modifies many existing domestic violence provisions.
  - Risk assessment tool underway is intended to provide consistency in sentencing alternatives.
- Item #6: Maggie Yates Court Date Reminders.
  - Failure to appear is a huge challenge for the courts and jail. Currently 24% of the jail population was released for an FTA warrant.
  - Court date reminders are issued at booking and one-way texting is under investigation now (still in the early stages of this project).
- Item # 7: Maggie Yates Justice Task Force Update.
  - So far 2 Task Force meetings have been held the next is scheduled for October 28, 2019 from 9:00 am − 12:00 pm. Presentations from those meetings are available on the Law & Justice website.
