Primary Election August 2, 2016 - Road Construction

SPOKANE COUNTY, August 1, 2016: If returning by mail, ballots must be postmarked no later than Election Day – Tuesday, August 2, 2016. It is important that voters check the pickup times on the mail box to ensure they are not too late. If the last pick up of the day has already been made, voters should use the county's ballot drop boxes.

A reminder that this is road construction season. Please plan accordingly when dropping off your ballot. Specifically road construction at the North Spokane Library and at the STA plaza.

North Spokane Library The road construction project on E Hawthorne Rd is between North Division St/SR395 and North Newport Hwy/US 2 and is part of the Stormwater Retrofit Project.

Directions from Division:

- Turn east on E Graves Rd
- Turn left on N Colfax Rd
- The North Spokane Library parking lot will be on the left

Directions from Newport Hwy/US 2:

- Turn west on E Graves Rd
- Turn right on N Colfax Rd
- The North Spokane Library parking lot will be on the left

STA Plaza Wall Street Construction Road work will cause the closure of Wall Street between Spokane Falls Blvd. and Main.
