DOING OUR PART...MASKING UP

The Governor's updated mandate regarding masks went into effect today and states that masks must be worn by those inside and outside at all events larger than 500 people.

As a reminder, you (or your company head) signed an agreement with the Fair that states in Section 15 (commercial vendors) or Section 16 (food vendors) that the "Licensee is fully aware of risks and hazards connected with the activity, including potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus and hereby agrees to comply with all Federal, State, and Spokane Regional Health District requirements."

We have all worked very hard to arrive at this moment in time and are thrilled that the Interstate Fair was allowed to open. To keep it open, however, we need all vendors to be in compliance with the agreement they signed. Failure to do so is a breach in your agreement and may result in a fine and/or closure of your booth.

We have masks available for the guests at each of the gates and signage is up stating the guidelines.
