## MASK UP...ITS MANDATORY

The Governor's mandate (effective 9/13/21) states that masks must be worn by those inside and outside at all events larger than 500 people.

As a reminder, you (or your company head) signed an agreement with the Fair that states in Section 15 (commercial vendors) or Section 16 (food vendors) that the "Licensee is fully aware of risks and hazards connected with the activity, including potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus and hereby agrees to comply with all Federal, State, and Spokane Regional Health District requirements."

Failure to abide by the Governor's mandate is a breach of your agreement and may result in a fine, closure of your booth, and/or exclusion from the 2022 Interstate Fair. We have all worked very hard to open the Fair this year and we need your help to keep it open. Please do your part and mask up.
