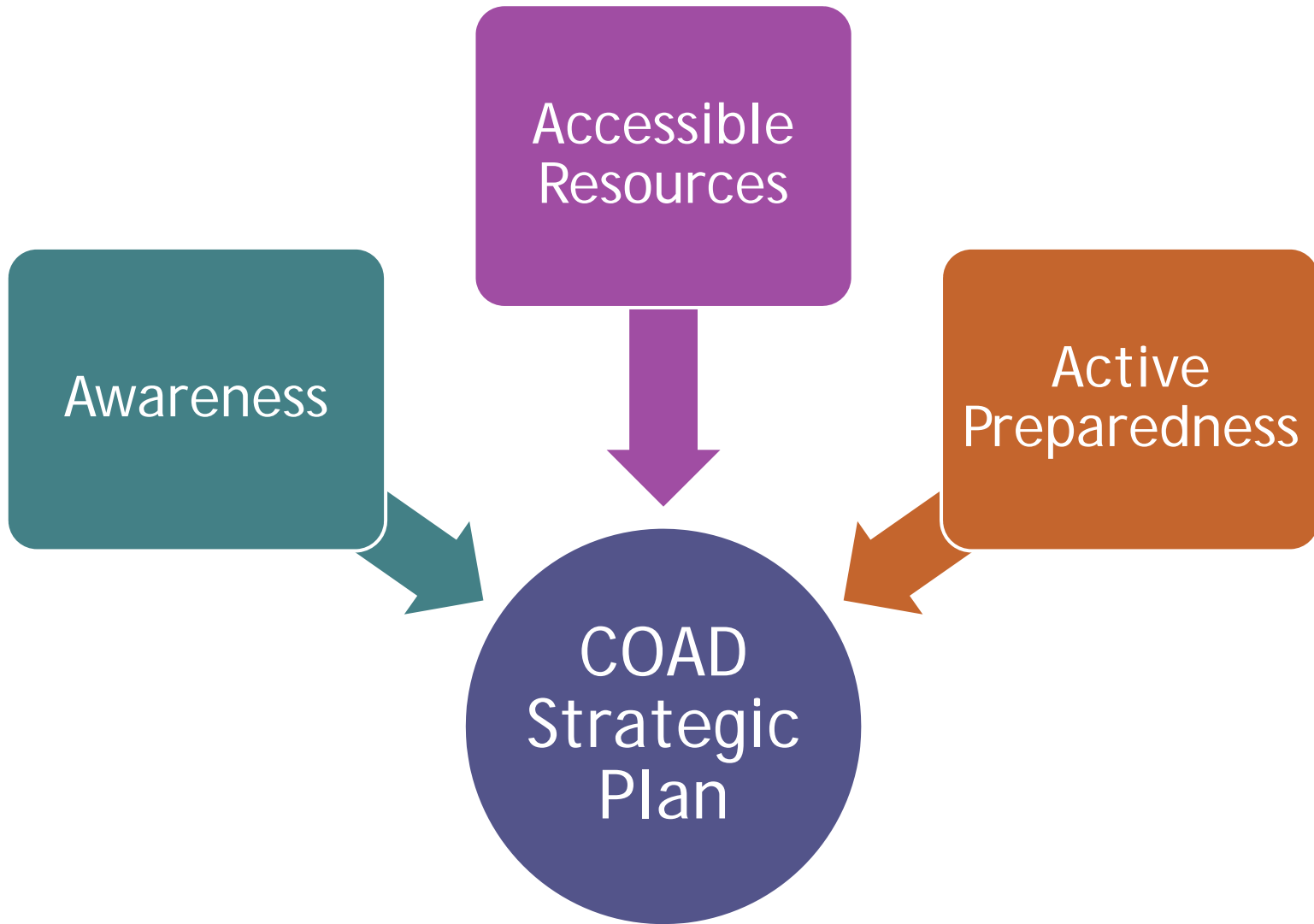
COAD Vision
