**BACKGROUND**

On June 13, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners, acting under the authority of RCW 36.70.795 and RCW 36.70A.390, repealed the Interim Ordinance adopted under Resolution No. 17-0095 and adopted a replacement Interim Ordinance on Processing Building Permits under Resolution No. 17-0537. That resolution provides in part as follows:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, Washington, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.32.120(6), RCW 36.70.795, RCW 36.70A.390, RCW 36.70A.130, Spokane County Comprehensive Plan Provisions Chapter 10: Natural Environment: NE: 18.1, NE: 18.7 and NE: 18.9 and WAC 197-11-880, that the Board declares an emergency and in so doing does adopt an Interim Ordinance as set forth in Attachment "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of the above scheduled public hearing will be for the Board of County Commissioners to receive and consider public testimony, deliberate and take appropriate action on affirming and extending the Interim Ordinance adopted under Resolution No. 17-0537 for a six-month time frame.
