
**Update 10/19/20:** Regional Fire Marshals lift burn restrictions for the Spokane area effective, Tuesday, October 20, 2020.

Coinciding with this, the Spokane County Parks, Recreation & Golf Director is hereby lifting fire restrictions across the Spokane County Parks System effective Tuesday, October 20<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m. The outdoor recreational fire restrictions were originally imposed earlier this year on July 20.

Where allowed in Spokane County owned and managed parks and unless otherwise posted, campfires in designated fire pits and the use of charcoal briquettes in park barbeques will again be permitted, effective October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 until further notice.
