

CITY OF MEDICAL LAKE RESOLUTION NO. 517

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEDICAL LAKE, WASHINGTON, rescinding Resolution 513 to submit a proposition for a six year replacement special levy for Emergency Medical Services to the voters of the City of Medical Lake on the November 6, 2018 ballot.

WHEREAS, the Medical Lake City Council adopted Resolution 512 to submit a proposition for a six year replacement special levy for Emergency Medical Services to the voters of the City on the August 7, 2018 primary election; and

WHEREAS, the Medical Lake City Council adopted Resolution 513 to submit a proposition for a six year replacement special levy for emergency medical services to the voters of the City on the November 6, 2018 general election in the event that the proposition submitted to the voters on August 7, 2018 did not receive sufficient votes to pass; and

WHEREAS, the proposition submitted for a six year replacement levy for emergency medical services placed on the August 7, 2018 primary election was approved by more than the statutorily required 60%; and

WHEREAS, the six year replacement levy for emergency medical services approved on the August 7, 2018 election is at the statutory maximum levy amount; and

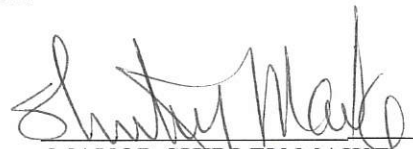
WHEREAS, the passage of the six year replacement levy for emergency medical services will provide sufficient funds to provide for the necessary expense of the Medical Lake Fire department for emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, there is no need for the ballot issue which is the subject of Resolution No. 513;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDICAL LAKE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Medical Lake hereby rescinds Resolution 513 submitting a proposition for a six year replacement special levy for emergency medical services to the voters of the City of Medical Lake on the November 6, 2018 general election.
