- The April 22, 2019 meeting minutes were approved, as written.

- 2. Presentation: Vivitrol: The Other Medically Assisted Treatment – Edgar (Ed) Hoffing, Board Member**
- Ed was unable to attend the meeting and will present the information to the Board at a later date.
- 3. Spokane County Administrative Updates**
- a. Trueblood Settlement Agreement Phase I Implementation Update – *Tonya Stern*
- The Trueblood Phase I Implementation goes into effect July 28, 2019. The three counties in Phase I are Pierce, South West and the Spokane Regions.
 - The Spokane Region has formed a regional workgroup at the approval of the Spokane County Board of County Commissioners (BoCC), which is focusing on identifying regional priorities that will align with the strategy in the Trueblood Settlement Agreement. See handouts for more information.
 - The monies mentioned in the Budget Summary is for the Trueblood Phase I Implementation for all three regions. There is a project manager assigned to our region who will look into what funds will be allocated for the Spokane Region. See the “Trueblood Overview” handout for information on priority funding areas.
 - A workgroup has been organized to review the supports, trainings, and workforce development services being suggested to meet the competency evaluation and restoration services timeline. The feedback from the work group will be presented to the Spokane County Regional Interlocal Leadership Structure (SCRILS) at the next meeting scheduled on Friday, June 28, 2019. Any additional feedback from the meeting will be added to the work group’s review that will be presented to The Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) Trueblood Project Management leadership on July 19, 2019 at the Spokane Regional Health District (SRHD) from 10:00a-12:00p.
- b. Spokane Regional Crisis Collaborative Meeting – *Tonya Stern*
- The next meeting is scheduled on Friday, June 28, 2019, from 11:00am – 12:30pm, at the SRHD.
 - Jan Dobbs, with Frontier Behavioral Health (FBH), will present on legislative changes related to the Involuntary Treatment Act (ITA) as a result of Senate Bill (SB) 5181 passing.
 - David Nielsen, with Northeast Washington Alliance Counseling Services (NEWACS), will present on the transportation challenges for the rural counties.
 - The next meeting will be held in September, 2019. Tonya Stern will present on in-region inpatient capacity for behavioral health acute voluntary and involuntary admissions.
