Treasurer's Office to Offer Extended Hours & Payment Locations Ahead of October 31st Property Tax Payment Deadline

Spokane County, WA- The Spokane County Treasurer's Office is encouraging taxpayers to take advantage of extended hours & payment locations ahead of the approaching October 31st property tax payment deadline. By state law, there is no grace period from interest and penalties being assessed after property tax payment deadlines. To provide another accessible in-person payment location, taxpayers have the option of paying by check or card at Spokane Valley City Hall on Friday October 25th from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The Spokane County Treasurer's Office will remain open Friday October 25th from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to accommodate taxpayers.

The Treasurer's Office sought out a regional partner to host satellite office hours during October tax rush. Spokane Valley City Hall provides taxpayers an accessible location to pay in person without having to travel to the courthouse. Treasurer's Office staff will be at Spokane Valley City Hall at 10210 E. Sprague Ave. 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Friday October 25th to take payments by check or card.

Courthouse hours set by the Board of County Commissioners require office closure at 1 p.m. on Fridays. Following the April tax deadline, Commissioners voted for a one-time hour extension on Friday October 25th to remain open until 4:00 p.m.

"The Treasurer's Office heard the peoples' concerns and responded by offering more ways to make your tax payments. In partnership with the City of Spokane Valley, we have seen week over week foot traffic increases for tax payments at Spokane Valley City Hall. Taxpayers have until October 31st to make their second half 2019 payments using any one of our convenient payment options." Said Michael Baumgartner, Treasurer of Spokane County.
