PLEASE READ BEFORE COMPLETION/SUBMISSION OF FORM:

Geiger Work Crew is a valuable resource to communities, neighborhoods, and organizations that are interested in organizing litter pick-up events. The Geiger Work Crew is available to help free of charge by a. providing supplies for litter collection and b. picking up the collected litter and hauling it to the nearest transfer station for disposal.

ORGANIZER

The organizer of the event must be available to receive the supplies delivered by the Geiger Work Crew and also return any unused or loaned materials upon pick-up of collected litter by the Geiger Work Crew.

INDEMNIFICATION/HOLD-HARMLESS

Organizer understands that the work environment presents the potential for serious injury, death and/or property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, equipment, weather, vehicular traffic and actions of others, including but not limited to, workers, spectators and volunteers. In consideration and participation of this event, the Organization agrees to hereby indemnify and hold Spokane County, its directors, officers, employees, representatives and agents harmless from any and all liability for the death, disability or personal injury as a result of this Event, unless the loss is caused by the sole negligence of Spokane County.

DATE OF PICKUP

The litter pick-up event must span one day only (for example: it cannot be a week-long or month-long event). Geiger Crew will pick up and transport the litter collected by the event one time.

LOCATION OF BAG PICK-UP

Please choose a location that would be accessible to a large truck.

RECYCLING

Spokane County Regional Solid Waste System emphasizes depositing recyclables that are clean, dry and empty. For this reason, Geiger Work Crew asks that if collecting recyclables along with trash, participants place only bottles and cans in the recycling bags and place paper and cardboard in the garbage.

DOCUMENTATION

Spokane County features neighborhoods, communities, and organizations that organize litter pick-up events. Photos and other documentation of the pick-up event can be sent to lmwirth@spokanecounty.org Geiger Crew will weigh the litter collected upon disposal and will relay the weight to the organizer.

SAFETY

Safety is the most important factor in organizing a litter pick-up event. Safety vests and cones can be requested in the submission form and loaned to the organizer for the event duration. Community pick-up events are safest when organized in a residential or arterial area. Main roads or highways are not acceptable areas for community litter pick-up events.
