

GENERAL NOTES

1. ALL WORK SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST EDITIONS OF THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND HIGHWAYS (WSDOT) STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES, AND THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES (SDP) STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS.
2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ALL NECESSARY PERMITS FROM THE APPROPRIATE AGENCIES.
3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ACCESS TO ALL ADJACENT PROPERTIES AT ALL TIMES.
4. ALL UTILITIES SHALL BE LOCATED AND DEPTH MARKED PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROTECTING ALL EXISTING UTILITIES AND STRUCTURES.

3. ALL STORM DRAINAGE SHALL BE INSTALLED AND MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT CONSTRUCTION.

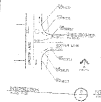
