A "Hold" refers to individuals who are in jail only for a detainer order and do not face any additional pending charges.

² Currently available data do not disaggregate misdemeanors by County, City and Valley charges. Because the County is billed for all felony charges, this combined category is attributed to Spokane County (as a Billing Agency).
