MOBILE CRISIS RESPONSE

MOBILE CRISIS RESPONSE (MCR) SERVICES PROVIDE CRISIS INTERVENTION AND SUPPORT TO INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES EXPERIENCING A BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CRISIS IN THE SPOKANE REGIONAL SERVICE AREA.

Mobile Crisis Response (MCR) services are available for individuals of all ages facing an urgent need related to a mental health and/or substance use disorder crisis to ensure personal, family and public safety. Services include:

- Crisis intervention and stabilization services
- Assistance accessing basic needs (medication, shelter, food)
- Evaluation and screening services
- Linkage to appropriate community-based services

MCR services help to reduce emergency room visits and psychiatric hospitalizations. This important resource is available for everyone; there are no financial eligibility requirements.
