**Petition to Transfer Guardianship
to the Receiving State
RCW 11.90.400**

I. Findings

- 1.1 A petition has been filed seeking transfer of this guardianship from Washington to:

- 1.2 A hearing was held on _____ (date).
- 1.3 Notice of this petition was given to those persons who would be entitled to notice of a petition in this state for the appointment of a guardian. RCW 11.90.400(2).
- 1.4 There has not been an objection to the transfer.

- has established that the transfer would be contrary to the interests of the incapacitated or protected person.
- 1.5 The court is or is not satisfied that the court of the other state is likely to accept jurisdiction.

- 1.6 The incapacitated person does or does not have sufficient ties to the other state to allow transfer:
- The incapacitated person is physically present in the other state; or
 - The incapacitate person is reasonably expected to move permanently to the other state; or.
 - The request is to transfer *only* the guardianship of the estate and the Incapacitated person had a significant connection to the other state, considering the factors in RCW 11.90.200(2).
- 1.7 Plans for care and services for the incapacitated person in the other state are are not reasonable and sufficient.
- 1.8 If transferring guardianship of the estate: Proposed arrangements for management of the protected person's property are are not adequate.

II. Order

- 2.1 The Petition to Transfer Guardianship is provisionally granted. The guardian shall petition for guardianship in the other state.
- 2.2. The Petition to Transfer Guardianship is denied and dismissed.
