

Welcome to the 2020 Virtual Fair for Livestock !



This year's fair theme of "Expect the Unexpected" became more than anyone could have imagined with the presence of COVID-19. A portion of the Spokane County Interstate Fair's mission statement states that we will "Serve as a showcase of the talents of our community by providing a means of education, exhibit, and competition". We look forward to a return of our traditional fair in 2021, however, we invite you to participate in our "virtual fair" this year. All entries for 2020 will be submitted online, judging will be done online, and comments from the judges will be shared with the exhibitor through e-mail. Thank you for your continued support of the Interstate Fair!

Rules for Entry

1. Exhibitors may reside in any U.S. State or Canadian Province.
2. Please check your department for entry fee that will need to accompany your entry form for this year's virtual event. Entry fees will be utilized to offset judging fees and will be placed into jackpot for the class winners (up to three).
3. Youth exhibitors must be 18 or under as of September 1, 2020. Youth exhibitors may enter open classes.
4. All entries (videos or photographs as the class requires) are due before midnight on August 21, 2020.
5. Entry Limits -
 - Fitting and Showing Exhibitors may enter once per species.
 - Costume Class Exhibitors may enter once per species.
 - Conformation Exhibitors may enter as many animals as they desire.
6. Classes will be split based on the numbers of animals submitted and the break out will be up to the discretion of the Fair staff.
7. Classes will need to have at least 10 animals to have their own division, otherwise they will show in the All Other Breeds (AOB) division or a combined age Fitting and Showing.
8. Animals can be fit or unfit, exhibitor's choice, in conformation classes. Animals MUST be fit for fitting and showing classes.
9. Youth entering in fitting and showing must be dressed as if entering the show ring including jeans and boots. Cowboy hats may be worn but are not required. Ball caps and visors are not permitted. Helmets are required for all youth horse riding class entries.
10. All animals must be owned or leased and in the exhibitor's care as of June 1, 2020. Market animals must be owned and in the exhibitor's care as of June 1, 2020.
11. Additional photos / videos may be requested at the discretion of the judge.
12. Staff may contact the exhibitor if the original submission is not clear enough.
13. Videos / photographs may NOT include any business signs / farm signs in the background.
14. Exhibitors submitting an entry consent to allowing the Spokane County Interstate Fair to use any provided photos, videos, and/or any other documents submitted in any publications, promotional materials, the Fair's website, social media platforms, and any other medium selected in the future without any restrictions or additional consideration.
15. Prizes are listed in each class as well as the sponsor who supported this year's competitive exhibit program and made this virtual event possible.
16. In 2020, exhibits will be judged on the American System (competing directly with other exhibits for the win). All others will receive a participation ribbon.
17. For 2020 only, checks and ribbons will be mailed to the exhibitor. Prior to mailing, an e-mail will be sent to the exhibitor announcing their winnings, asking them if they would like their ribbon(s), and asking them if they would like to donate their winnings to the Fair this year or receive a check in the mail.

How to Submit an Entry



1. Open your camera on your phone.
2. Turn your phone so that it is horizontal to take the photo / video (screen should be wide not tall).
3. **PHOTO ENTRIES:**
 - Photos for conformation classes should be submitted in a jpg format.
 - Each entry must include a front view, side view, and rear view taken within 10-14 feet of the animal as the exhibitor stages or sets the animal up as they would in the show ring. Rabbits include front, side, and from top.
 - Take photos in a well-lit area outside and try to reduce shadows and glares.
 - Make sure the animal is not standing in tall grass or deep shavings.
 - Aim for the center of the intended view with your body - don't tilt the camera, bend over, or get down low as it will distort the shape of your animal.
 - Photos may not be altered or edited!
 - E-mail photos (with information listed below) to fair@spokanecounty.org. Once we receive your entry form and payment, the photos will be uploaded on our for the judge's review.
4. **VIDEO ENTRIES:**
 - Videos for fitting and showing classes must not be longer than 2 minutes (including the introduction). Any videos longer than 2 minutes will be disqualified.
 - All animals / exhibitors should be introduced verbally at the beginning of the video to assist the judge. For example, "My name is (insert your name) and this is my Hereford heifer born (insert date). Her name is (insert name). This year, I completed the ___ Grade (insert school grade you completed in June 2020). I am a member of (insert club / chapter)." As a note...You do not need to be a 4-H or FFA Member to participate in the Interstate Fair but if you are a member, it is always nice to recognize your group.
 - Exhibitor must be included in all video angles.
 - All videos submitted must include audio and coaching is not permitted during the video.
 - Submit videos via Google Drive at [drive.Google.com](https://drive.google.com). After uploading your file, please send an e-mail to fair@spokanecounty.org with the link and include the information listed below.
 - ◇ Create a Google account or if you already use Gmail, you can use your login information to access [drive.Google.com](https://drive.google.com). If under the age of 13, 4-H members are asked to have their videos submitted through their parent / guardian's account.
 - ◇ Once Google Drive is open on your desktop, click "New" then "File Upload". This will open your file browser to search for the file you are wanting to send. Click on the file then click "Open". Another option is to drag and drop the file into the Google Drive window on your phone app.
 - ◇ Wait for the file to upload making sure you have a strong internet connection. Do NOT close the window while uploading or the process will be canceled.
 - ◇ Right click on the file name and click "Share".
 - ◇ Type "fair@spokanecounty.org" in the "Add people and groups" field, type in your name in the "message" field, then click "Done" or "Send".
 - Include your name (first and last) and phone number (in case we have questions) in the body of your e-mail.
 - You will receive a confirmation e-mail from the Fair Staff within 24 hours of the entry being received (a little longer if submitted over the weekend). If you do not receive one, please call the office at 509.477.2772.

Electronic submission is preferred, however, if you do not have access to a device to submit your entry electronically, please mail your color photos (3" x 5" or 4" x 6") for conformation classes or a thumb drive with your video for fitting and showing classes to Spokane County Interstate Fair, 404 N Havana St Ste 1, Spokane Valley WA 99202-4663 **BEFORE** August 21, 2020. Include your entry form and payment. The Interstate Fair also has a mailbox at the Fair Office that allows you to drop off your entry if that is more convenient for you. Photos and thumb drives will NOT be returned to the exhibitor unless a self-addressed, stamped envelope is included with the entry.


What Can I Enter This Year ?

Fitting and Showing Additional Information

Refer to the prior page regarding how to take and submit a video.

VIDEO CONTENT REQUIRED FOR SUBMISSION:

- Videos must not be longer than 2 minutes (except rabbits and poultry). Rabbit and poultry videos must not be longer than 4 minutes. Videos longer than the stated length will be disqualified.
- Begin video with introduction (see prior page).
- Include all sides of the animal with the youth moving to the appropriate position for presenting the animal (pretend the camera operator is the judge). Conclude with the youth moving the animal away from the camera to show the movement of the animal, coming to a complete stop at the end of the video and setting up the animal one last time. * / **
- Fitting and Showing entries are required from exhibitors desiring to be a part of this year's virtual market sale. If you are in need of help selling your animal in 2020, please notate it on your entry form.
- *Fitting and showing requirements for rabbits include carry, pose, turnover, eyes, nose, teeth, front feet / legs, belly, rear feet / legs, sex, tail, and fur. During the video the exhibitor should explain to the audience what is being shown. Exhibitor must also answer the three following questions:
 1. What is the breed, showroom variety, and sex of your rabbit?
 2. What is the original purpose of this breed?
 3. What one fact can you share that is directly related to the care of rabbits?
- **Fitting and showing requirements for poultry include pose bird on table surface (profile to camera), move bird to carry position, return to pose (opposite profile to camera), and display four parts of the bird (one wing and three of contestant's choice). During the video the exhibitor should explain to the audience what is being shown. Exhibitor must also answer the three following questions:
 1. What is the breed, variety, and sex of your bird?
 2. What is the original purpose of this breed?
 3. What one fact can you share that is directly related to the care of poultry?
