After the August entry deadline date, if additional space remains, we would love to fill our pens with OPEN animals that would receive an exhibit fee to do so. We realize that family and small farms are a vital part of the community and economy and we would like to continue in the tradition of supporting these farms while educating the public through engagement with YOU. Those interested in attending the fair to fill the barn with OPEN animals would be allowed to promote their animals, services, and farm-related goods for sale. 3. During the second week of the fair, we will have beef cattle in the barn on display only (no judging). At this time, the barn pens have been filled for 2021 but if you would like to be on a stand-by list for openings, please reach out to Second Half Superintendent Teresa Balderrama.
4. Please know that this decision has been made for 2021 only and we hope that you will make plans to join us for our full show in 2022 (September 9-18). We cannot wait to see all of you again!
