

- The most recent employers' ERISA statement, and a statement of contribution since that statement, of any pension plan of either party;
- A written appraisal of any real estate, antiques, jewelry or other items of special, unusual or extraordinary value or a summary of the evidence which will be relied upon;
- A verified extract or copy of the most recent N.A.D.A. Official Used Car Guide or Appraisal Guide showing both average loan or wholesale and retail values for any automobiles;
- A summary of the source and tracing of any property asserted to be the separate property or obligation of either party;
- A statement from each life insurance company issuing a policy of insurance on the life of either party as to its cash value and any loans on the cash value;
- A written appraisal of any proprietorship, partnership or closely held corporation of the parties, or a summary of evidence which will be relied upon.
