

# Evacuation Guidelines

## What do the evacuation levels mean?

### Level

### 1

#### Get **READY** to leave!

- ◆ Prepare to leave your current location
- ◆ Conditions could get worse due to the incident in your area
- ◆ Put your **GO BAG** by the door and include any important items you may need, such as phone numbers, medication, clothing, etc.
- ◆ Consider what your pets will need to evacuate

### Level

### 2

#### Get **SET** to leave!

- ◆ You should be prepared to leave at a moment's notice
- ◆ Dangerous conditions threaten your current location
- ◆ The incident may be limiting the emergency services' ability to protect the area
- ◆ If you or anyone at your location needs extra time, you are strongly encouraged to leave now
- ◆ If you have pets and/or livestock, you are encouraged to leave now. If you need help evacuating them, please call 911

### Level

### 3

#### **GO, Leave immediately!**

- ◆ There is an immediate threat to your safety—you need to leave **NOW**
- ◆ Emergency services may not be able to assist you
- ◆ Remember to bring your pets with you
- ◆ If you have pets and/or livestock, and need help evacuating them, please call 911
- ◆ You will not be allowed to return until conditions are safe
