Trained staff offer support at sexual assault forensic medical exams and medical advocacy at local hospitals and the Child Advocacy Center. They support families and household members experiencing domestic violence and help survivors of any age along with their loved ones; they can also help individuals access housing, medical treatment, community counseling services and referrals to their robust behavioral health programs.
