Description of proposal: Spokane County Public Works is proposing to construct a roundabout at the intersection of Freya Street and 57th Avenue. The existing intersection consists of 2-way stop control on Freya St. only. Modifications and improvements include curbing, sidewalk, ADA facilities, drainage structures, illumination and paving.
