



From I-90:  
 -Take the Maple Street exit, #280  
 -Drive north on Walnut/Maple Street approximately 4 miles  
 -Turn left (west) on Francis Avenue, drive 1 mile  
 -Turn right (north) on Indian Trail Road, drive for 4.7 miles  
 -Indian Trail Road turns into Rutter Parkway, drive for 1 mile  
 -Van Horn, Edburg and Bass Conservation Area is approximately 1/4 mile after the Painted Rocks parking area, on the left  
 -Enter at the driveway that has a large, white metal bar. Walk for 1/4 mile  
 -Enter the Van Horn, Edburg and Bass Conservation Area at the southeast corner


