Description of proposal: Spokane County Public Works is proposing this project to improve drainage and eliminate ponding in the roadway by installing stormwater pipes and catch basins to direct stormwater to existing detention ponds.

Location of proposal: The project is in the West Terrace area southwest of the City of Spokane and south of the Spokane airport. Work will take place along Hayford Rd, Richland Rd, Fruitvale Rd, Strawberry Rd, Raspberry Rd, Blackberry Rd and Barberry Rd. Section 7, Township 24N, Range 42E Spokane County, WA

SEPA Environmental Review: Spokane County has reviewed the proposed project for probable adverse environmental impacts and expects to issue a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS). This determination is based on the following findings and conclusions:
