The Spokane Regional Law & Justice Council (SRLJC) is seeking applicants to fill a vacancy in their membership. This position is an At-large Community Representative with specific interest and experience in victim advocacy. The new member will promote/share the views and perspectives of victims on the Council.

This is a voluntary position and will be completing the current term that is set to expire in October 2023. (It is possible for this position to be re-appointed for additional term(s) by the Board of County Commissioners).

The SRLJC currently meets once a month on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday from noon to 1:30.

The following are the At-large Community Representative duties:

SRLJC at large members shall:

- a. Attend monthly meetings (or if unavailable, appoint a proxy and inform the Law & Justice Office in advance)
- b. Provide regular input to the SRLJC and committees from the community at-large as well as the specific area of interest each person was appointed to represent.
- c. Cooperatively plan and implement a regular community engagement process.

Individuals with prior criminal history are encouraged to apply, however the applicant can have no pending criminal cases in any jurisdiction. All cases must be closed, and the individual can no longer be on probation.
