

# **LIBERTY LAKE REGIONAL PARK CAMPGROUND**

## **INFORMATION & RULES**

### **FEES\***

- Tent camping is \$24.00-\$30.00 per day and includes entry fees for 4 people and 1 vehicle per site.
- R.V. camping is \$32.00-\$47.00 per day and includes entry fees for 4 people and 2 vehicles per site. Example, an RV plus a towing truck, tow behind car or separate vehicle.
- Group tent camping site is \$43.00-\$64.00 per day and includes entry fees for 12 people and 3 vehicles.
- Cabin rentals are \$58.00-\$100.00 per day and include entry fee for 4 people and 1 vehicle per site. Cabin Pet Fee is \$15.00/reservation. Max 2 dogs per cabin.
- Additional person(s) are \$2.00 per day with a maximum of 8 people per tent/RV site and 16 people per group site. There is a maximum of 6 people allowed to stay inside the cabins. A total of 8 people can stay on each cabin site if a tent is used on the cabin lawn. (*Additional tent site adjacent to Spruce Cabin is available for additional fee, which increases capacity to 16 total.*)
- All additional vehicles are \$5 per day.
- Firewood is \$5.00 per bundle. Other camp stores items are available including ice, water, tshirts, mugs, and other camping supplies, subject to availability. Camp store is open 10am-7pm daily.
- Reservation fee is \$7 per reservation. Reservations can be made online at [www.spokanecounty.org/parks](http://www.spokanecounty.org/parks) or by calling (509) 477- 7274.

*\*Fees are subject to change annually. Fees listed above are correct as of 2021.*

### **RESERVATIONS**

- Take the stress out of planning your stay by reserving early! Reservation fee is \$7 per reservation. Reservations can be made online at [www.spokanecounty.org/parks](http://www.spokanecounty.org/parks) or by calling 509-477-7274.
- Online reservations are available 24 hours a day for your convenience.
- Reservations by phone are available at 509-477-7274 at the following times:
  - May 1 - September 30: Sunday - Saturday 10:00am - 7:00pm
  - October 1 - April 30: Monday - Friday, 8:00am - 4:30pm
- Reservations can be made 12 months in advance of your intended stay, but no later than two days prior to your arrival. To make a reservation with 48 hours of arrival, contact the Camp Hosts at 509-477-7274 for availability.

### **RULES**

- If you are staying at the campground, you must camp only in those places specifically provided or marked.
- All vehicles, RVs, and trailers must be parked on your campsite driveway. Driving or parking off road is prohibited.
- Check-In Time: 3:00 pm. Check-Out time: 11:00 am. For early check-in, confirm with Campground Host.
- 14 night maximum stay, at which point guests must check out for a minimum of 48 hours before starting a new stay.
- Quiet hours are between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.
- Additional vehicles may only park in the designated parking space for the site being reserved. At no time should vehicles be parked on the grass within the campground. Any vehicles that are unable to fit within the designated parking area of each reserved campsite must be relocated to the overflow or main parking lot near the park entrance.
- RV's are not permitted at the cabin sites.
- Tents may only be placed within the cabin site.
- Campsites must be occupied nightly.
- Spokane County is not responsible for any loss or damage to personal property.

### **SANITATION**

- All garbage and litter must be disposed of in provided trash receptacles or taken with you when you leave.
- No dumping of any kind shall occur outside of proper receptacles/containers.

## CAMPFIRES

- Open fires may be prohibited at certain times during high fire season.
- Fires shall only be built in fire rings, stoves, grills, or fireplaces intended for that purpose.
- Do not leave your fire unattended. Completely extinguish fire before leaving. You are responsible for keeping fires under control.
- Do not put cans, bottles, plastic, food or rocks in fire ring.
- Do not start campfires with gasoline or camping fuel.
- Keep flammable materials away from campfires.
- Follow fire restrictions when in place. Fires left unattended will be subject to a fine.

## VEHCILE OPERATIONS

- Drivers must obey all traffic signs and operate their vehicle in accordance with posted regulations, and applicable Federal, State and local laws.
- All motorized vehicles, camping units, and trailers must stay on designated roads, parking areas, or camping pads.
- Use of vehicles within campground is limited to entering or leaving the campground on authorized roadways.
- When operating vehicles of any kind, do not damage the land or vegetation, nor disturb wildlife.

## PETS AND ANIMALS

- NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE PUBLIC BEACH.
- Dogs must be restrained or on a leash no longer than 6 feet at all times.
- No more than 2 dogs per site.
- Dogs shall not be left barking or unattended. If your dog is disrupting others, you may be asked to leave.
- Owners are responsible for cleaning up waste from their pets.
- Do not gather, collect, or harm plants or wildlife. Feeding of wildlife is strictly prohibited.
- Dogs (except service animals) are not allowed in swimming areas or sanitary facilities.
- Saddle or pack animals are only allowed where authorized by posted instructions, or Spokane County personnel.

## FIREWORKS/WEAPONS

- Discharge of fireworks, firearms, explosives, incendiary devices, bow and arrows, wrist-rockets, paintball guns, airsoft guns or other weapons is prohibited.

## PUBLIC PROPERTY

- Leave no trace. Leave natural areas better than you found them.
- Cutting trees and shrubs or damaging natural resources is prohibited.

## GENERAL NOTICE

- All visitors and users are subject to federal, state and local laws.
