

DISTRICT COURT TO SUPERIOR COURT PROTECTION ORDER TRANSFER PROCESS

- If District Court determines that your petition should be heard in Superior Court:
 - District Court will enter an Order Transferring the case to Superior Court
 - The Temporary Order or Note for Hearing issued by District Court, will set the hearing in Superior Court within 14 days – please look for your hearing date, time, and location on the Temporary Order for Protection or Note for Hearing.
 - Superior Court holds Protection Order hearings on:
 - Monday and Thursday @ 8:30 a.m.
Courtroom 202 or by Zoom ID # 402 876 2240
 - District Court will then send the Temporary Order of Protection or Note for Hearing to law enforcement to be served.
 - District Court will also scan and email the entire file to the Superior Court Clerk's office.
- Once the file is received from District Court, the Superior Court Clerk's office will assign a case number and calendar the hearing.
- Any return of service or other documents received by District Court on a case that has been transferred to Superior Court will immediately be sent to the Superior Court Clerk's Office.
