

# DIVORCE WITH CHILDREN IF CHILDREN OF MARRIAGE RECEIVE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE (TANF)

## SPOKANE COUNTY FAMILY COURT FACILITATOR

If you or your spouse receive public assistance for the children born of this marriage, the Family Law Prosecuting Attorney's Office at West 1026 Broadway, Spokane, Washington 99260 must receive notice and approve of the child support provisions in the divorce.

### Checklist of Steps to Complete:

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. When you begin your divorce, you must take copies of the dissolution papers to the Family Law Prosecuting Attorney's Office.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. When you prepare all of the final divorce papers (*Findings and Conclusions About a Marriage, Final Divorce Order, etc.*) you must take the following documents to them:
  - ( ) *Child Support Worksheets*
  - ( ) *Child Support Order (FL All Family 130)*

You must deliver these papers to the Family Law Prosecuting Attorney, at West 1026 Broadway, Spokane, Washington 99260 at least fourteen (14) days before your final hearing date. They must review them and sign off on these final papers before the court will sign the final papers.

You will need to pick the papers up from the Family Law Prosecuting Attorney before your final hearing date and bring them to Court on your court date.
